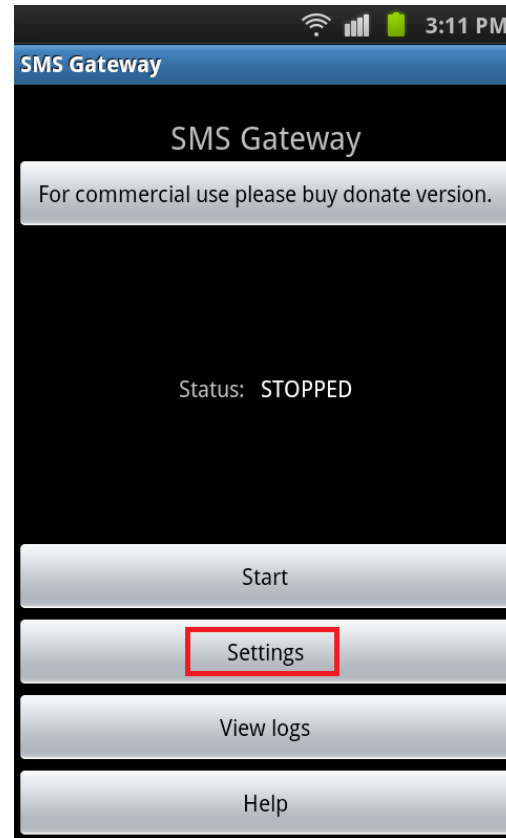
1.  Show My IP

2.  SMS Gateway

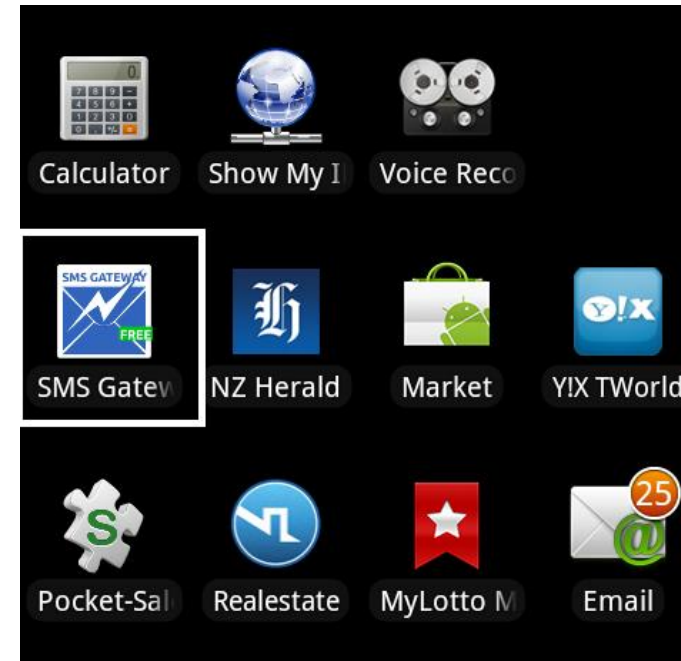
- Switch your phone's Wi-Fi on. Make sure your phone is connected to the internet.



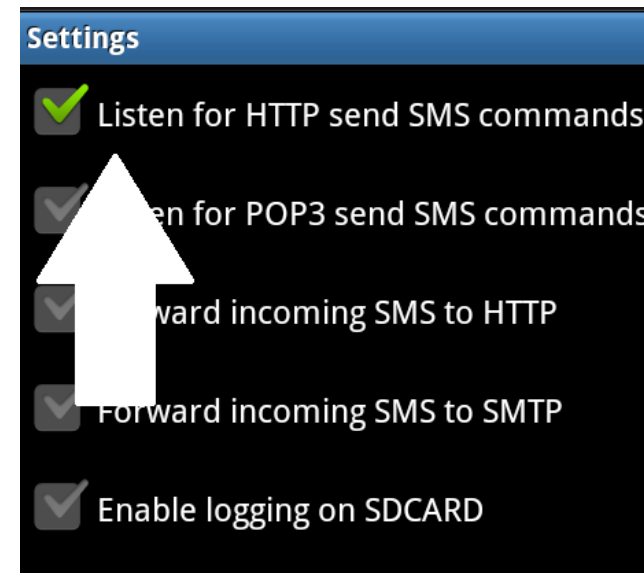
1. Open SMS Gateway



2. Go into Settings



3. Tick *Listen for HTTP send SMS commands*

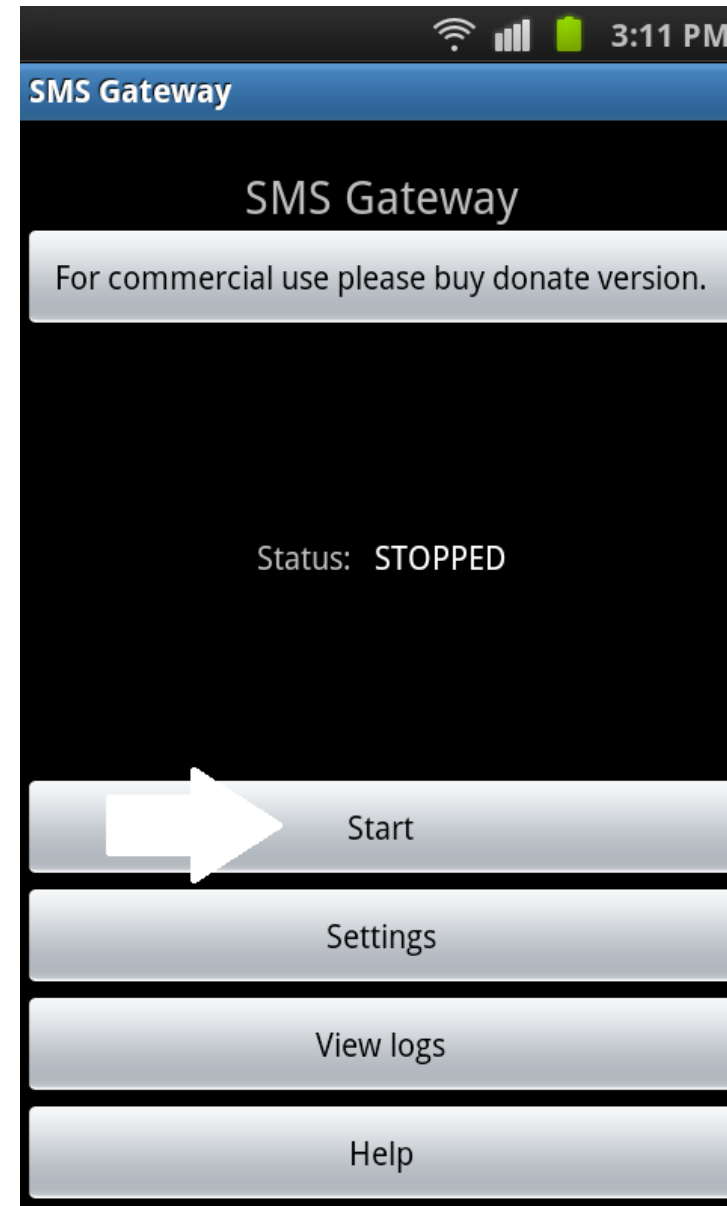
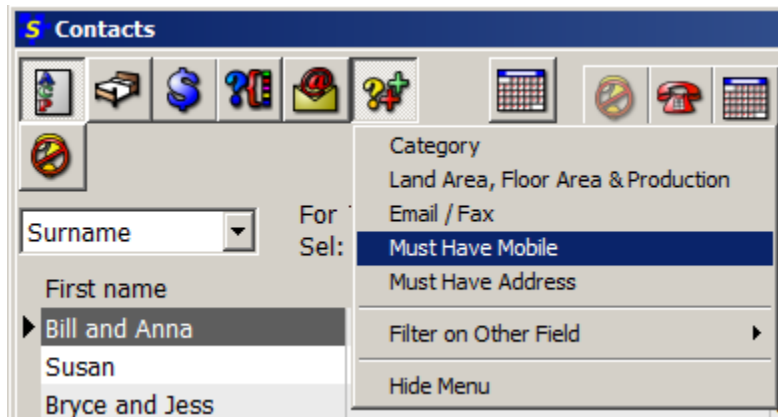


4. Go back to the main menu and tap *Start*


5. In SalesPartner, open Contacts



**Tip:** use the *Must Have Mobile* filter



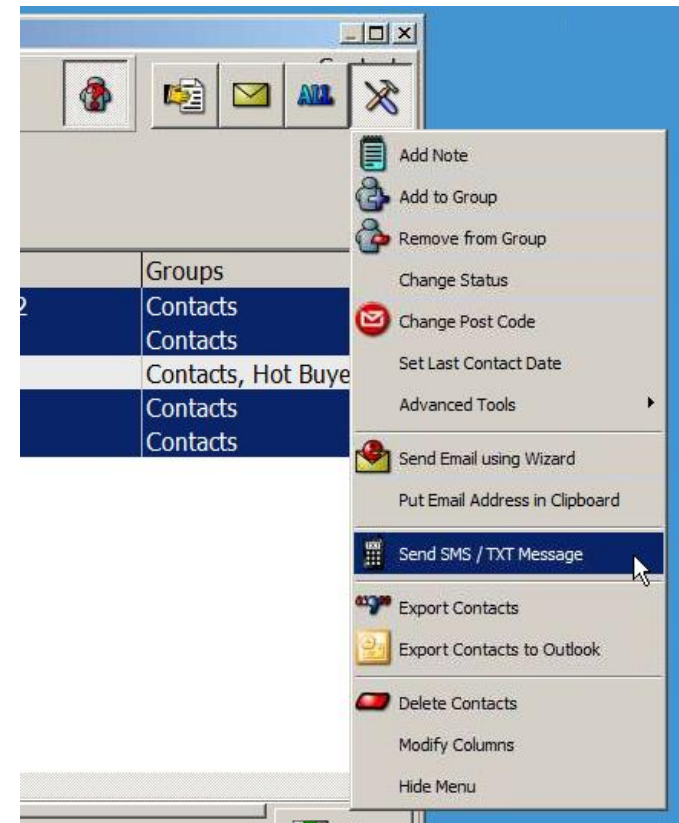

- click **Send SMS / TXT Message**



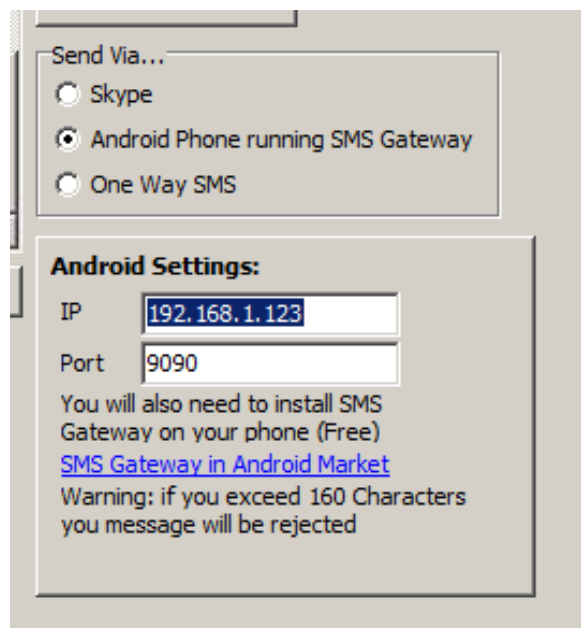


Open the **Show My IP** App on your phone



### Tips:

- Send a copy to yourself by using the *Add Yourself* button.
- Use the Merge Fields button to personalise your SMS message to each recipient.
- Save your Templates for future use – click on *Save Template*.
- Click on *Add Opt Out Message* to include an unsubscribe feature.

Sent SMS messages are recorded in Activity.

Remember to comply with the Unsolicited Messages Act. If a client wishes to unsubscribe, remove the label "Mobile" from next to their phone number. This will ensure that they will not receive future text messages.
